*Taxi*. Easy to grow, determinate 5 oz yellow fruits. Meaty and blemish free. 64 days.

*First Lady II*. Popular early tomato on the market. Excellent, early flavor. 67 days. AS, F2, N, TMV, V

*Marglobe*. Solid 6 ounce fruit that is crack resistant. 72 days. V, F1

*Celebrity*. Very popular among gardeners everywhere. Good taste. 72 days. F2, N, TMV, V

*Rutgers*. Standard medium tomato great for sandwiches, canning and cooking. 75 days. F1, AS, L.

*Brandywine*. The best tasting pink tomato. 1 pound plus fruits are common. 78 days.

*Paragon*. Vigorous determinate vines with 8-10 oz firm tomatoes. Great for shipping, retains taste. 78 days. F2, V.

*Yellow Brandywine*. Orange standard. Excellent taste. 78 days.

*Striped German*. Bicolor tomatoes. Fruity flavor slicing tomato. 78 days.

*Black Krim*. Russian heirloom that has purple skin with green/black shoulders. Outstanding smoky flavor. 80 days.

*Golden Jubilee*. Sweet and meaty. 8 oz orange fruits. 80 days. AS.

*Amish Paste*. 8 oz oxheart fruits good for canning. Excellent flavor, old heirloom. 85 days.

*Bellstar*. 5 oz plum fruits, determinate. Easy to harvest, handles cold weather. 65 days.

*Washington Cherry.* Globe shaped fruits. Meaty and flavorful. 60 days.

## Peppers

*Big Bertha.* Elongated 9 to 12 oz fruits. 7 inches long. 3 lobed. Ripens green to red.

*Fat N' Sassy.* 4 ½ inch fruits. Sweet and thick-walled. Ripens green to red. Excellent taste! 63 days.

*King of the North.* Blocky green fruits that do well in colder climes. 70 days.

*Valencia.* 4 inch orange fruits. 4 lobed. Sweet tasting. 72 days.

*Hungarian Wax.* Similar to banana peppers. 5 ½ x 1 ½ inches. Ripens yellow to red. 58 days yellow.

*Cayenne.* 5 to 6 inches long. Ripens bright green to red. Hot. 80 days.

*Poblano/Ancho.* Mildly hot, 4 to 6 inch dark green fruits. Used to make chile relleno and mole. 90-110 days.

*Amish Pimiento.* 2 x 4 inches with an excellent sweet fruity taste. 85 days.

*Allysum, Carpet of Snow.* Good nectar source for beneficial insects. Also good for hanging baskets. Blooms throughout the season.

*Calendula, Flashback.* Unusual rusty-red purple color on the backside of semi-doubled orange, rusty-red, and cream petals.

*Calendula, Orange Zinger.* Bright orange flowers.

*Marigold, French Brocade mix.* Standard yellow-orange, reddish-orange blooms.

*Marigold, Diamond Jubilee Mix.* Impressive yellow and orange flowers on compact 18 to 24 inch plants. AAS selection.
